

The construction industry historically pays the highest effective federal tax rate of any industry in the U.S. economy.


Treasury Department Effective Actual Corporate Tax Rates by Industry for 2007–2011

Member companies that achieve the highest level of performance in ABC's safety program are 770 percent safer than the BLS industry average.*


